RACE DAY INFORMATION

WORCESTER PITCHCROFT 10K Wednesday 15th July 2026

Several years ago this race moved from its traditional weekend date and time, to become an evening midweek event.

We hope you will continue to support this local race for the benefit of the local running and athletic community. Thank you.

PARKING – Please use only the centre course car park (**free – 2.1m height restriction**) accessed from Severn Terrace (WR1 3EH). The car park will be open and stewarded from 6pm but please note that **the gates will be locked at 9.30pm strictly**.

REGISTRATION – Collection of **pre-entry race numbers** and **ankle-tag timing chips** (transponders) is from a dedicated desk in the Grandstand concourse. Please note that numbers **MUST** be worn pinned to the **front** of the vest **only**; they must not be folded or mutilated in any way. **THERE IS NO ENTRY ON THE DAY.** **You must complete the medical information on the reverse side of the number.**

TOILETS - Male and female Portaloilets are located in the centre course opposite the Grandstand (no disabled access). Public and disabled toilets and baby-changing facilities (all 20p.) are also located 200 metres south on Grandstand Road.

CHANGING/BAGGAGE – Sorry, we are unable to offer changing or baggage storage at this event.

START – The start time is **7.30pm** at the far end of the paddock (short walk). We wait for the final fun runner to finish!

COURSE – The course utilises the racecourse perimeter surfaced tracks and paths, the route is traffic free and holds a measurement certificate and UKA race licence. The race is run over 3 laps. Kilometre markers are placed at halfway 5K

AUDIO/MP3 EARPHONES - For reasons of safety we do not permit the wearing of earphones (including bone) - you may not hear our marshals' instructions, or other runners and park users approaching from behind. ***Competitors who ignore this request may have their finishing position deleted from the official results.***

DRINKS - We supply water only. Water is available in open containers on lap 2 and at the finish. Please place used cups in marked bins.

WHEELED CARRIAGES/FANCY DRESS/DOGS – **In the 10K** – dogs, push chairs, prams and large structured fancy dress are **not permitted**.

DISABLED COMPETITORS - We welcome disabled competitors at this event. ***Please contact the organiser before entering*** to discuss requirements and course detail.

REFRESHMENTS – Hot and cold beverages and light snacks will be available from our barista style vendor.

RESULTS – **10K CHIP TIMED (New for 2026)** - Will be displayed on the club website. We aim to award prizes at 8.45pm approximately.

10K AWARDS Gun Times – Trophies will be awarded to the first 3 men and first 3 women. Prizes will also be awarded in the following masters categories and **1st U20 male and female**.

1st M40 - M50 - M60 - M70+

1st F35 - F45 - F55 - F65+

1st Male and 1st Female Team (affiliated clubs only - 3 runners to close by place)

The first 3 place prizes are awarded irrespective of age groups i.e. if the 1st, 2nd, 3rd placed runner is a veteran, then the next runner in that category will be placed 1st Veteran, and so on. One prize per competitor (excepting team).

FUN RUN Awards 1st Male (under 18) and 1st Female (under 18)

County Championships Eligibility

UKA Rule 21 S6 - (a) By birth in the County. (b) 9 months continuous residence in the County prior to competition. (c) By 9 months service in a unit of HM Forces stationed in the County. [Worcestershire is defined by the pre-1974 boundary and includes parts Birmingham]. **Rules** Only first claim athletes can score in team competition. Only Clubs affiliated to Worcestershire County are eligible for team awards. Official Club colours must be worn - UKA Rules 143 S1 (advertising) (clothing) and 143 S2 (numbers) apply.
